

# AFRICAN WILDLIFE & BIRDING TOURS 2007

## **TOUR 307 KRUGER, BOTSWANA, ZIMBABWE TO VICTORIA FALLS** (Aug. 16 days)

This expedition will travel to areas that are seldom visited but where birding & wildlife prospects are highly rated. The tour is for experienced travellers looking for places off the tourist routes & for the old Africa experience.

## **TOUR 407 VICTORIA FALLS, CHOBE, OKAVANGO RIVER, CAPRIVI, ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK, NAMIBIA.** (Sept. 16 days)

Contrasting habitats ensure good wildlife & birding opportunities on this tour. Visit the great rivers – Zambezi, Chobe & Okavango – look for African Skimmers, Pel's Fishing Owl & Wattled Cranes. Sable & Roan Antelope are seldom seen together, but both are present in Mahango Reserve. The tour ends in the desert Park of Etosha Pan where a highlight will be the herds of beautiful Southern Oryx as well as possible sightings of now rare Black Rhino.

## **TOUR 507 NAMIBIA CLASSIC. NAMIB DESERT COAST, WATERBERG PLATEAU & ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK.** (Sept. 16 days)

Our classic Namibian tour is a favourite for those liking dry places. We visit the coastal Namib Desert, the Spitkoppe mountains and the world famous Etosha Park. Birds are in summer plumage just before the rains & early migrants have returned to the coastal wetlands. The herds of game in Etosha are collecting at the waterholes before their summer migration & make for spectacular viewing.

## **TOUR 607 TRANSCONTINENT TWO GREAT NATIONAL PARKS – ETOSHA & KRUGER.** (Oct. 16 days)

Combining two of Africa's greatest wildlife areas into one special trip. This tour crosses the continent from west to east - the variety of wildlife is exceptional & probably could not be surpassed in any trip of similar length.

## **TOUR 707 SOUTH AFRICA WILDLIFE & BIRDING CLASSIC. KRUGER, ZULULAND COAST & DRAKENSBERG MOUNTAINS.** (Oct. 16 days)

Our perennial favourite which has remained unchanged for the past 10 years. This is a comprehensive wildlife & birding experience for travellers of any age who may only "do" Africa once in their life. Nowhere can match Kruger Park for species diversity & with over 300 bird species possible, this tour is highly recommended.
